B+ Terminal Stud

Replacement Instructions

DANGER

This symbol is used to indicate the presence of hazards that will cause severe personal injury, death or equipment damage.

WARNING

This symbol is used to indicate presence of hazards that can cause major equipment damage.

CAUTION

This symbol is used to indicate the presence of hazards that can cause minor personal injury or equipment damage.

- Turn off engine.
- Disconnect battery master switch.

CAUTION

- 4. Using double nuts, install adhesive end of new 15 lb. ft.




Figure 1 - B+ Terminal Stacking Order

5. Install B+hardware in stacking order shown in Figure 1.

DANGER

Failure to follow stacking order will result in substantial equipment damage.

CAUTION

More than three cable lugs on B+ output terminal are not recommended. To properly engage terminal, B+ stud threads must be exposed min. 1/8" and max. 3/4" after all hardwarde is stacked and secured.

6. Start engine. Check for alternator output.
