Support cables within 305 mm/ 12 in. of EPM. Failure to do so can cause component damage.

- 4. Test components to make sure they operate properly.




Figure 1 - Cable Arrangement (See Wiring Diagram on Page 2)




Figure 2 - Stacking Order and Torque




Figure 3 - Simple Wiring Schematic
