Install N1235-1 alternator/N3134 Regulator per diagrams on pages 1 and 2.




Figure 1a – N3134 Regulator Wiring Connections





Figure 1– N1235-1 Alternator

torque to 21 Nm / 15 lb.ft.




Disk spring

Flat washer




Alternator is shipped with spacer-tag in this position.
Remove spacer-tag and replace with
Vehicle "B+" cable lug.



The vehicle B+ cable lug must fit over the shoulder insulator without damaging it. Failure to properly seat the terminal and other hardware can result in major damage to components and other equipment.




Figure 1c – Ground Terminal Stacking Order
